



## CISC Roles and Responsibilities

### Age Group Directors

Reports to Director of Coaching. Year round, part time job, 2-10 hours per week flexible schedule as required to maintain a visible presence at soccer facilities and evaluate coach performance.

Role is to ensure competitive and recreational coaches understand and implement age appropriate coaching philosophy, development goals, and training curriculum.

### Responsibilities

- Support the Director of Coaching in defining the coaching philosophy, development goals, and training curriculum for assigned age group.
- Communicate the age group coaching philosophy and training curriculum to coaches working with children in designated age group
- Monitor and assess recreational and competitive coach performance
- Provide back up coaching as requested by Competitive Program Director or Director of Coaching when regularly assigned competitive coaches are unavailable
- Participate and support club try out planning and implementation as requested by the Director of Coaching.
- Attends Annual General Meeting
- Supports vertical club structure and assists the Director of Coaching in implementation
- Attend and participate in Coaches Meetings
- Maintain a visible presence at competitive soccer matches and tournaments

### Minimum Requirements

- Must have a D soccer license or ability and commitment to acquire one within 1 year of accepting Age Group Director role
- Ability to work flexible schedule needed to maintain presence at soccer facilities

- Public Relations skills
